# **Suburban League Sports Policies**

SPORT: WRESTLING

## A. League Schedule

All league matches will be scheduled in a single round robin format and held as three double dual matches and one single dual match. A four year schedule will be adopted by the athletic council.

### B. League championship and/or tournament

A league championship will be determined by the following formula:

- 1. In dual matches the following points will be awarded as listed here:
  - 2 points for each win
  - 1 point for each tie
  - 0 points for each loss
- 2. In the league tournament matches the following points will be awarded:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> place 14 points
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> place 12 points
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> place 10 points
  - 4<sup>th</sup> place 8 points
  - 5<sup>th</sup> place 6 points
  - 6<sup>th</sup> place 4 points
  - 7<sup>th</sup> place 2 points
  - 8<sup>th</sup> place 0 points
- 3. The team with the most points from the dual matches and the league tournament matches will be declared the champion. If two teams tie for first place, co-champions will be declared.

#### C. Officials

All officials will be hired by the league commissioner.

#### D. Rules

Rules are those established by the National Federation and the OHSAA. All schools will abide by these rules as well as policies formulated by the league athletic council.

### E. Facilities and equipment

Locker room facilities shall be provided for the visiting team.

#### F. Publicity

The home school shall report match results to the designated media.

#### G. Game/meet/match time and activities

Visiting team shall have the use of the mat to warm up prior to the contest. Dual meet matches shall begin at 6:00PM. The order for teams wrestling in double dual matches shall follow the printed league schedule.

#### H. Crowd control

Home team is responsible for crowd control.

#### I. Finances

Ticket prices shall be established by the athletic council.

#### J. Cheerleaders

Must be in uniform and must keep a safe distance from the mat.

#### K. Video tape and film

Guidelines established by the OHSAA.

#### L. Junior varsity and freshman regulations

Regulations as set by the athletic council.

#### M. Middle school regulations

Single round robin format for scheduling; each team wrestles each other team once in a simple dual match.

## N. All-league selection process

The league tournament at the end of the season shall decide the All League individuals for  $1^{st}$  and  $2^{nd}$  team, plus Honorable Mention for  $3^{rd}$  and  $4^{th}$  place finishers.

## O. Miscellaneous

In order to be seeded in the league tournament, a wrestler must have wrestled in at least 4 league matches. For seeding purposes, only league matches are considered.

Coach of the year shall be the coach of the Championship team.
