Suburban League Soccer Sports Policies

A. League Schedule

• A single round robin schedule will be used with each team playing the other schools one time. All league games will be played according to the approved league schedule.

B. League championship and/or tournament

• The league championship will be based on a point system: using 3 point for a win; one point for a tie, and 0 points for a loss. The team with the most points will be declared the champion. In the case of a tie for the championship, there will not be any tie breakers – teams tied will be declared co/tri champs.

C. Officials

• Officials will be assigned by an independent soccer assigner, approved by the league. For varsity contests there shall be a center official and two side officials; for JV and freshman contests, two officials shall be assigned.

D. Rules

• Rules used will be those established by the National Federation and the OHSAA.

E. Facilities and equipment

- The National Federation has established a description of required equipment. The Home school has the responsibility of making this equipment available.
- Team seating and spectator seating within each stadium will be determined by the home team's athletic administrator.

F. Publicity

• The home team shall report the game results to the designated media.

G. Game/meet/match time and activities

• JV games are scheduled for 5:00; varsity games at 7:00. Freshman games shall be played at a time mutually agreed upon by both league schools.

H. Crowd control

• The home school has the responsibility of providing an appropriate number of faculty members and/or police so there will be adequate protection for spectators and officials.

I. Finances

• League guidelines for ticket prices will be followed. No pre sale tickets will be sold.

L. Junior varsity and freshman regulations

- Junior varsity games to follow the same single round robin schedule as the varsity.
- Freshman games to be scheduled by mutual agreement between schools.

M. Middle school regulations
